For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and
Annexures P-7 and P-8 are taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

CRM-M-17739-2021

This is a petition that has been filed for quashing of the order
dated 25.02.2021, whereby the petitioner herein has been declared as a
Proclaimed Person in proceedings that were initiated under FIR No.21 dated
24.01.2020 under Sections 406 and 420 of the IPC at Police Station City
Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein seeks to assail the said
order by contending that the proclamation was not in terms of Section 82

Cr.P.C. It is also contended that in fact the matter now stands compromised between the parties and the complainant would have no objection in case the proclamation order is set aside.

Learned counsel for the complainant, who is present in Court, has no objection in case the order declaring the petitioner herein as a Proclaimed Person is set aside.

Without going into the merits of the impugned order passed, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner to put in his appearance before the trial Court at Phagwara, District Kapurthala within a period of 10 days from today and on doing so, he would be admitted to bail, subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

In the meantime, as the matter stands compromised, the arrest of the petitioner is stayed limited to his putting in appearance on or before 28.03.2022.

Consequently, the impugned order is set aside and the petition stands disposed of in above terms.
