Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR No.543 dated 26.08.2018 registered under Sections 323, 354, 506, 509 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 8 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat (Annexure P-1), alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise deed dated 29.03.2022 (Annexure P-2) and affidavit (Annexure P-3) of the same date.

In view of the observations made by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **State of Madhya Pradesh Vs. Laxmi Narayan and others (2019) 5 Supreme Court Cases 688**, prayer made in the petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise, cannot be entertained.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
