Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner while in service was entitled for the grant of 3rd ACP but the said benefit has not been extended to the petitioner and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by serving upon them a legal notice dated 20.03.2020 (Annexure P-1) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 20.03.2020 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 20.03.2020 (Annexure P-1), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 20.03.2020 (Annexure P-1) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
