Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0080 dated 18.02.2022 under Sections 148, 149, 307, 324, 341, 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act (Section 201 and 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Model Town, Rewari.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 21.04.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Akshay submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 21.04.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 21.04.2022 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
