Prayer in this petition is for setting-aside the order dated 02.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by the trial Court vide which the bail/surety bonds of the petitioner were cancelled and forfeited to State in FIR No.130 dated 07.08.2019 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 307, 325 IPC added later) at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar (Rural).

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was granted regular bail by the trial Court vide order dated 25.02.2020 and he was regularly appearing before the trial Court, however, due to some miscommunication, he could not appear before the trial Court on 02.04.2022 and his bail/surety bonds were cancelled.

Counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court and face the proceedings, in accordance with law.

Counsel for the State has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the present petition is allowed, the order dated 02.04.2022 is set-aside and the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and the trial Court will release the petitioner on bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds and on payment of costs of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Jalandhar.

The payment of costs shall be a pre-condition before accepting the bail/surety bonds of the petitioner.
