AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition was filed for issuance of directions to the official respondents for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners from the private respondents No. 4 and 5 arrayed in the petition.
2. As per the pleadings, the petitioners had performed marriage against the wishes of their parents and there was a threat perception.
3. On 21st April, 2022 following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

Mr. Amit Mehta, Senior DAG, Punjab, appearing on advance notice accepts the same and seeks time to have instructions.

Put up on 11.5.2022.

In the meantime, the police officials not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police should record the statements of the petitioners.

In case a request is made by the petitioners, they may be provided shelter in safe house till the next date.”

4. Reply dated 11th May, 2022 filed by learned State counsel annexing the statement of the petitioner No. 1 that there is no threat perception and statement of respondent No.5 Chhinder Kaur stating that she and her relatives have accepted the marriage solemnized by her daughter.

5. In view of the above, no further directions are called for, the petition is disposed of.
