Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in COCP-1255-2021, titled as “Chanchal Singh and others Vs. Virender Kumar Dahiya and another”, dated 18.11.2021, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the order reads as under:-

“This petition is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioners to file an appeal against order dated 30.06.2021 passed by the General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Ambala before the Director, State Transport, Haryana.

If the petitioners file appeal within 15 days from today, it is expected that the Appellate Authority shall endeavor to dispose of the same within three months thereafter.”

Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions from Sh.Bhupender Ahlawat, ADA, Transport Department, submits that the pending appeal shall be decided within a period of one month, from today.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, no further orders are required to be passed.
