[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 27.05.2019, in CWP No.14315 of 2019 in case titled as '**Amarjit Pal Kaur and others** versus **State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.14315 of 2019, was disposed of vide order dated 27.05.2019 by directing the respondents that in case any representation was filed by the petitioner within 02 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, to take appropriate decision on the same by passing a speaking order within 03 months thereafter.

[3] Learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, has produced copy of speaking order dated 29.06.2022, accepting the claim of the petitioner and directing financial benefits to be paid as per entitlement determined in the said order. The aforementioned speaking order dated 29.06.2022 is taken on

record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, while directing the respondents to release the benefits as per entitlement determined in the aforementioned order within a stipulated period of time.

[4] Learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, on instructions from *Shri Didar Singh, Deputy DEO (E.E.)*, states that financial benefits in terms of order dated 29.06.2022 would be released to the petitioner within 02 months from today.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while directing the respondents to ensure release of payment in terms of entitlement determined vide order dated 29.06.2022 within 02 months from today, failing which the same shall be released along with interest @ 6% with effect from the date of entitlement till date of payment and in the eventuality of the payment not being released to the petitioner within the stipulated period of time and interest becoming payable, interest paid shall be recovered from the officer(s) responsible for not releasing the payment within the stipulated period of time.
