By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR No. 270 having been registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur, on 15.12.2021, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 419/465/467/468/471/120-B of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a similar petition filed by the petitioner, i.e. CRM-M-2216-2022, was withdrawn on 19.01.2022 (when this court was not inclined to admit him to bail), thereafter on 25.03.2022 a co-accused of the petitioner, i.e. Harinder Singh, has been admitted to bail under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. by this court (coordinate Bench), vide an order passed in CRM-M-2057-2022.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

A copy of the petition be given to learned State counsel by counsel for the petitioner today itself.

He submits that the petitioners' case is wholly different from that of Harinder Singh, inasmuch as the petitioner got another woman to impersonate as his mother to transfer her land in his own name, whereas Harinder Singh was only a witness to that transfer deed.

In view of the above, I find no ground to entertain this petition, which is consequently, dismissed, it being one seeking that the petitioner be admitted to anticipatory bail.

However, nothing observed hereinabove will be taken to be a comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, which would be wholly gone into as per evidence gathered and led before the trial court (if it comes to that stage).
