By way of present petition, the petitioner seeks directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to register an FIR by acting on the complaints bearing No.1431/PO dated 25.05.2020 and No.2817-PD dated 13.07.2020 given by the petitioner, against private respondents No.5 and 6.

It is the case of the petitioner that though the aforesaid applications/representations have already been submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, yet the same have yielded no result. It is further submitted that the conduct of the proceedings at the end of the police authorities clearly shows them being hand in gloves with the culprits.

The petitioner is aggrieved against the inaction on the part of the police authorities. In view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S. Janaki and another, 2020(2) RCR (Criminal) 788, in case of non registration of an FIR, the remedy of

the aggrieved person is not to approach this Court, but s/he is at liberty to approach the Magistrate concerned under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C.
