Admittedly, the petitioner has been convicted under Section 306 IPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of seven years. Appeal against the order is pending, and thus, criminal proceedings are pending in a Court of law in India. Thus, the petitioner is not entitled to re-issuance of a passport unless and until he approaches the Court concerned where proceedings are pending.

In view of above, this petition is disposed of with liberty to approach the concerned Court where the criminal proceedings are pending.
