On 21.04.2022 following order was passed:

“Through instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.90 dated 05.04.2022 under Sections 294/452/509 IPC and Section 506 IPC added later on registered at Police Station Sadar Tohana, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the offences except Section 452 IPC are bailable. Furthermore, the FIR has been lodged as a counter blast to the FIR No. 44 dated 19.02.2022 under Sections 406/420 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Tohana, District Fatehabad at the instance of Kiranpal Kaur, the daughter-in-law of the petitioner against Ajit Singh, the husband of the complainant.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Zorawar Singh Chauhan, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 21.07.2022.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) of Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has joined the investigation in pursuance of the interim directions issued by this Court.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the aforesaid factual aspect and has stated that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 21.04.2022 is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
