Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.243 dated 29.09.2021, registered for offences under Sections 346, 365 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Ranjit Avenue, District Amritsar, Annexure P-1.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has joined the investigation pursuant to order dated 22.04.2022 passed by this Court.

This fact has been ascertained by the State counsel, who has instructions to state that the petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, but without examining the merits of the case, present petition is allowed.

Order dated 22.04.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
