This is a petition seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 12 dated 20.1.2022, under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station City Samana, District Patiala.

The petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail on 22.4.2022. Thereafter, two more opportunities were granted to the petitioner to join the investigation but as per counsel for the State, he failed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was nominated in another FIR of the year 2020 in which prayer for bail was rejected.

In view of the above facts, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail, as the petitioner is not in a position to join investigation.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions submits that the petitioner would surrender within three days and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

The petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner surrenders within three days from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned will take up the application

for regular bail in accordance with law.

Since the main petition has been disposed of, pending application, if any, is rendered infructuous.
