HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioners are fully eligible as per rules governing the service and hence, they are entitled for salary of Rs.57,700/- per month instead of Rs.35,400/- per month.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners will raise appropriate claim before the authorities concerned by filing a detailed representation showing the fact that the petitioner is fully eligible to hold the post in accordance with the rules governing the service and hence are entitled for the salary of Rs.57,700/- and the respondents may kindly be directed to decide the same as expeditiously as possible.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioners, the same will be decided by the

authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed, with liberty as prayed for.
