This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case of FIR No. 2 dated 5.4.2022, under Sections 7, 7(a) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 as amended by P.C. (Amendment) Act, 2018, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, District Ferozepur.

Vide order dated 19.5.2022, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail subject to joining investigation.

Short reply by way of affidavit is taken on record.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custody is not required.

Learned counsel for complainant vehemently opposes the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, the interim anticipatory bail granted is made absolute.
