Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had applied for the post of LDC in the Ex-serviceman category. The name of the petitioner had appeared in the merit list. He has been denied appointment only on the ground that the Ex-serviceman dependent certificate was issued after the last date of filing of the application form. He, however, contends that there is no dispute with regard to the authenticity of the certificate or that the petitioner is a genuine dependent of Ex-serviceman. He has relied upon the judgment of the Supreme Court passed in SLP (c) 27550 of 2012 titled as **Ram Kumar Gijroya vs. Delhi Subordinate Service Selection Board**. He also contends that he has sent a representation (Annexure P-11) to respondent No.1 in this regard and would be satisfied if this petition is disposed of with a direction to decide the same in the light of the aforementioned judgment.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Mandeep Singla, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Heard.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider the representation (Annexure P-11) in the light of the afore-noted judgment and other relevant material and take a decision in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
