Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Surjit Singh Sahota (IFS) D.F.O.A.S.R submits that upon reconsideration, the respondents have decided to withdraw the impugned order dated 09.02.2022 (Annexure P/8) and prays that a liberty be given to the respondents to pass a fresh order in accordance with law keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case coupled with the law laid down by the Division Bench of this Court in CWP-2371-2010 titled as **Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab and others.**

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the impugned order dated 09.02.2022 (Annexure P/8) has been withdrawn by the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

It will be appreciated, in case after passing of fresh order, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him within a period of next four weeks.
