The instant petition has filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 68 dated 15.04.2020 (Annexure P-1) registered under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner *inter alia* contends that he does not press the instant petition in so far as the relief under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is concerned, however, he prays that the petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court and the trial Court may be called upon consider bail petition so filed by the petitioner after his surrender.

Needless to mention that in the event the petitioner surrender before the Trial Court and moved an application for seeking regular bail, such application shall be duly considered by the Trial Court and the reasons cited by the petitioner for his previous absence shall be looked into and in the event the same appears to be reasonable, genuine and offer valid explanation, sympathetic consideration thereof

shall be taken by the learned trial Court.

The petition is disposed of as aforesaid.
