The prayer in the application under Section 482 Cr.PC is for amendment in Sections of FIR in the head note as well as in the prayer clause in the present petition as Section 201 IPC has been added later on during the investigation of the FIR for proper adjudication of the case.

For the reasons stated in the application duly supported by affidavit of petitioner himself, the same is allowed.

Registry is directed to make necessary amendments in Annexure P-1(FIR), in the head note as well as in the prayer clause of the petition.

The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory

bail in case FIR No.0025 dated 26.03.2022 under Sections 379 and 411 IPC and (Section 201 IPC added vide order dated of even date passed in CRM-23453-2022) registered at Police Station Doraha, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 05.05.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 05.05.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 05.05.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
