In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 06.07.2022 followed by the order dated 11.07.2022, an affidavit dated 16.07.2022 of the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala, along with which is the medical report dated 12.07.2022 submitted by the Medical Officer, Central Jail, Ambala. The aspect with regard to the ailment of the petitioner is primarily age related which is wear and tear, which has led to the reduction in height of L₃ Vertebrae with Osteophytes seen. In clause 10 thereof, it has been mentioned that the health condition of the petitioner is stable with medications and the petitioner is able to walk and not bedridden.

In the light of the above, we do not find any ground for accepting the prayer made in this petition for grant of parole on medical grounds, especially when he is being properly taken care of. The same, therefore, stands dismissed.

Direction, in any case, is give to the respondents to ensure that proper treatment is provided to the petitioner so that his pain can be reduced.
