Complaining violation of directions issued by the High Court in Civil Writ Petition No.1671 of 2021, dated 16.03.2021, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

The operative part of the order dated 16.03.2021, reads as under:-

“Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with directions to the official respondents to consider legal notice dated 30.10.2020 (Annexure P-9) as representation moved by the petitioner and to decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

It is evident that on the very first date of hearing, the writ petition was disposed of while issuing directions to consider a notice dated 30.10.2020, allegedly sent by the petitioner and pass speaking order thereon.

Before initiating contempt proceedings, one more opportunity is granted to the official respondent-Deputy Commissioner, Kaithal to comply with the order with a period of one month, from today.

Let a copy of the order be sent by the petitioner to the Deputy Commissioner, Kaithal, by the registered post acknowledgment due within a period of 10 days.

It is hoped that the Deputy Commissioner will comply with the order, failing which the petitioner shall have liberty to file an application for revival, if the order is not complied with.

With all these observations, the present petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
