[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 03.11.2021 in CWP No.21187 of 2021 in case titled as Balbir Singh vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.21187 of 2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 therein to decide the claim of the petitioner as per the averments in the writ petition by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to any pecuniary benefit then to release the same to the petitioner within a further period of three months.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to issuance of notice to the respondent on 11.05.2022, needful has been done and benefits as per entitlement have been released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
