SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Since it is stated at the bar, by the learned State counsel, that after framing of charges against the accused for offences, constituted under Sections 341, 506, 34 of IPC 1860, the learned trial Court has, out of 18 prosecution witnesses recorded the testifications of 8 prosecution witnesses.

2. Therefore, since the trial is pending, and, has progressed to the above stage, before the learned trial Magistrate concerned, and, also when some of the offences carried in the FIR (supra), and, in the charge, are non-compoundable also with the leave of the learned trial Judge concerned. Thereupon until the learned trial Judge makes a lawful verdict of conviction, upon charges, as arises, from DDR/Rapat No.35, dated 28.04.2015, registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar, arise from FIR No.97 of 28.04.2015, registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar City, this Court does not deem it fit to, through exercising the mandate of Section 482 Cr.P.C. to, proceed to quash, on the basis of a compromise drawn amongst the accused, and, the

complainant, the FIR (supra), and, also the above drawn consequential proceedings. The above recourse can be made by this Court, only after an appeal, if any, becomes preferred thereagainst, before the learned Appellate Court concerned.

3. Consequently, at this stage, the petition is not maintainable, and, it is disposed of, as such. However, liberty reserved to, at an appropriate stage, recourse this Court through a petition cast under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

4. With the afore observations, the petition is disposed of.
