(1) This order shall dispose of the above-cited petitions under Section 439 CrPC wherein the petitioners have sought regular bail in case FIR No.0034 dated 28.02.2022 under Sections 22/29/58 of Narcotics Drug and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

(2) Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that they have been implicated falsely which is a result of a dispute between Hardev Singh ASI and Sunil Gill. The alleged recovery has been shown from the diggy of the scooter which belongs to Harjinder Singh and no recovery has been effected from the petitioners.

(3) Learned State counsel has produced custody certificate, and is

taken on record, according to which, the petitioners are already behind the

bars for 4 months and 24 days upto 27.07.2022 (the date of custody certificate) and 5 months and 21 days upto now, there is no other case pending against them as is evident from the custody certificate.

(4) Considering the aforesaid discussion and that no recovery is to be made from the petitioners who are in custody since 28.02.2022 and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on their furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, concerned.
