These petitions have been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 74, dated 24.03.2015, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under the provisions of Section 365 of the IPC (with Sections 302/201/34 of the IPC having been added later).

Today, a report dated 22.11.2021 is on record, shown to be sent by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, stating to the effect that the appeals filed by both appellants against the order dated 05.12.2018 passed by the learned Principal Magistrate Juvenile Justice Board, Ludhiana,

had been dismissed on 17.11.2021, with the main case pending for recording the statements of the accused under the provisions of Section 313 of the Cr.P.C., the next date of hearing at that stage being 24.11.2021.

That being so, with all prosecution evidence already being complete, I would see no reason to entertain these petitions at this stage at least, which are consequently dismissed even though counsel for the petitioners is not present, it being well past 04:00 p.m.
