Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.235 dated 04.10.2019, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda.

At the outset, learned State counsel on the instruction from HC Avtar Singh, submitted that only one prosecution is to be examined and the case before the learned trial Court is fixed for today itself.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR was registered on 04.10.2019 and since then the petitioner has been in custody. At this stage, he restricts his prayer to the extent of issuance of direction to the learned trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of one month.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court, to make an endeavour to conclude the trial preferably within a period of three months in accordance with law.
