Prayer is for grant for anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.21 dated 02.02.2021 registered under Sections 21/61/85 of NDPS Act, 1985, Police Station Special Task Force, District Special Task Force Wing, Mohali.

The counsel for the petitioner apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police on the basis of order of interim bail dated 13th September, 2021. The State counsel on instructions from SI Gurnek Singh has admitted this fact and further stated that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

The FIR in the present case was registered on the basis of secret information, on which police raided the disclosed place and arrested Chiranji Lal, Parveen Singh and Sona Singh and recovery of 270 grams of heroin was effected from them. As the recovery has already been effected in this case and the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation, this Court is of the view that the concession of anticipatory bail could be granted to the petitioner.

In the light of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order granting interim bail dated 13.09.2021 to the petitioner is hereby made absolute subject to the condition envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
