1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 19.08.2021, in CWP-12232-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 19.08.2021, reveals that CWP-12232-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide legal notice dated 01.05.2021, after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, concerned stockholders and affected parties by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has placed on record copy of order dated 30.05.2022, passed by the respondents closing the complaint on account of there being no merit in the same. The same is taken on record and copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances the petitioner is not

withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 30.05.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
