The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C read with Section 483 IPC praying for quashing of FIR No.13 dated 7.2.2008 registered under sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station, Haryana, District Hoshiarpur along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom including the order dated 20.5.2009 whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to pursue the present petition, at this stage and prays for withdrawal of the same with liberty to avail his remedy before the court of competent jurisdiction. Counsel further prays for indulgence of this Court as regards challenging the order dated 20.5.2009 whereby the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.

In case the petitioner arrives in India on or before 26.5.2022, she would have the protection from arrest for a period of 10 days from the date of her arrival in India to enable her to file an appropriate application/revision before the court of competent jurisdiction and in that

case the concerned court is requested to deal with the application/revision filed by the petitioner in accordance with law. Petitioner would be at liberty to approach this Court again after the decision of proclaimed offender proceedings.
