Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the marriage has taken place vide Annexure P-3 on 17.04.2022 it is clear from the vernacular of the Nikahnama/Marriage Certificate but inadvertently the same has been wrongly typed as 01.08.2021 and at the time of translation, it was only a typographical mistake and thereafter again typographical mistake is occurred in Para No.5 of the petition. He further submitted that it is only a typographical mistake otherwise the marriage has taken place on 17.04.2022. He also submitted that petitioner No.1 was earlier married but she was divorced and so far as petitioner No.2 is concerned, he is also married but under the customary law of Muslims he can enter into second marriage as well.

Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-4) dated 18.04.2022, in this regard to the Superintendent of Police, District Nuh.

Heard. Record perused.

Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General, Haryana.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Naveen S. Panwar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

The petitioners have placed on record the copy of Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 & P-2) as proof of their age. They have also placed on record the Nikahnama/Marriage Certificate as Annexure P-3.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 & 3-Superintendent of Police, District Nuh and the Station House Officer, Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh that representation, if any, filed seeking protection of life and liberty, be looked into and contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is made clear that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court regarding marriage of the parties.
