MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.28 dated 30.01.2022 under Section 61 Punjab Excise (Haryana Amendment) Act, 2020 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Salhawas, District Jhajjar, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 29.04.2022, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that as per allegations, the liquor was being sold illegally from the vend licensed to one Rajesh and petitioner has been implicated falsely on the basis of disclosure statement made by co-accused- Nar Singh. According to him, the recovery of the alleged liquor has already been made, therefore, his custodial interrogation may not be necessary.

Notice of motion for 26.05.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance

of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by HC Sandeep Kumar states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 29.04.2022 is made absolute.
