Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking directions to the respondents for conducting the investigation of FIR No.121 dated 15.06.2018 under Sections 409 and 420 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Garhshankar from some senior police officer and also to array the respondent No.5 as an accused in the said FIR.

Learned State counsel has apprised that the investigation in the present case is already complete and the accused has been declared as 'Proclaimed Person' and that a final report under Section 173 of the Cr.P.C. has already been presented by the Illaqa Magistrate where the proceedings under Section 299 of the Cr.P.C. have already been initiated.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be given.

Disposed of accordingly.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the alternative efficacious remedy available to him in accordance with law.
