Arvinder Singh against the petitioner and his other family members.
Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the
petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to
the petitioner to file a fresh petition for quashing of the abovesaid FIR.

It is made clear that in case if the fresh petition would be filed, the same would be considered independently on its merits, in accordance with law.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of, in view of the abovesaid order.
