HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that without considering the claim of the petitioner, who is a displaced Extension Lecturer in the subject of Chemistry, the respondents are appointing fresh candidates as Extension Lecturer which is contrary to the policy.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the policy, which has been issued by the respondents on 04.03.2020, as amended on 11.05.2022, the Extension Lecturers, who are already working with the respondents, have a preferential right to be readjusted, which benefit is not being given to the petitioner for the reason best known to the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by filing a representation dated 30.03.2022 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 30.03.2022 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 30.03.2022 (Annexure P-6), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 30.03.2022 (Annexure P-6) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
