AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents as they were threatening to dispossess the petitioner from the house.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State Counsel had filed reply dated 5.7.2022.

From the reply, it is forthcoming that the petitioner was accused in FIR No. 29 dated 7.3.2022 under Sections 325, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, 1860 registered at P.S. Sirhali lodged by Harpreet Singh-respondent No.5 in the present petition. The allegations against the petitioner and the co-accused were found false and cancellation report was prepared.

In paragraph No. 5 of the reply, it is stated that with regard to

the representation filed by the petitioner, enquiry was conducted and during enquiry the petitioner appeared before the Enquiry Officer and got her statement recorded that she does not want to take action against the private respondents.

In view of the reply filed, no further directions are called for.

Petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievance, if any.
