The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of FIR No.410 dated 3.6.2021 registered under sections 323, 498-A, 506, 406 IPC at Police Station, Yamunanagar City, District Yamunanagar and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail the alternate remedies as available to the petitioners in accordance with law. She has further prayed that the parties, who are aged persons may be allowed exemption from personal appearance before the Trial Court.

In view of the above prayer, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for. So far as prayer for granting exemption from personal appearance to petitioners is concerned, the trial Court is directed to consider the application moved by the petitioners for the grant of exemption from their personal appearance during trial subject to the petitioners filing affidavit to the following effect:-

1. That petitioners will have no objection if the statements of witnesses are recorded in their absence but in the presence of their counsel.

2. That they will appear before the trial Court as & when required to do so by it.
3. That they will abide by any other condition imposed by the trial Court while granting them exemption from personal appearance.
