Petitioner has approached this Court impugning the order dated 10.02.2022 passed by learned Family Court, Faridabad, wherein the interim maintenance @ Rs.12,000/- per month has been granted to the petitioner-wife.

Learned counsel has submitted that the gross salary of the respondent-husband is Rs.63,308/- per month and hence the amount awarded as interim maintenance is on the lower side.

Learned Family Court has taken into account the submissions and the attending circumstances of the case, as the statutory provisions of Section 125 Cr.P.C. are to prevent the destitution and vagrancy. The petitioner has no minor child with her to take care. The interim maintenance granted @ Rs.12,000/- per month during pendency of the main petition is appropriate. This Court finds no infirmity in the order passed by learned Family Court as the same is the subject to the outcome of the final maintenance, which is yet to be decided.

In view of the same, the present petition being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed.
