Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take strict legal action against the private respondents No.6 and 7 (wife and son of deceased Indermohan Singh), who allegedly got transferred his property by wrongly declaring his mother Pritam Kaur as dead.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that respondent Nos.6 and 7 got the property transferred in their favour in the year 2009, and mutation was entered on 18.12.2009 (Annexure P-3), and at that time, Pritam Kaur was alive, but she never challenged the transfer during her life time, who died in the year 2016. The representation against respondent Nos.6 and 7 was given by petitioner on 14.10.2020, whereas the present petition has been filed in April, 2022.

Considering the above background and the nature of the allegations, this Court is not inclined to exercise inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C., as the petitioner can also avail alternative remedy.

Dismissed.
