Prayer in the application is for impleading one of victim-Harmandeep Singh as respondent No.8 and to place on record the amended memo of parties.

Learned State counsel and learned counsel for non-applicant-petitioners, submit that they have no objection, if the application is allowed.

In view of the above, the application is allowed. Harmandeep Singh is impleaded as respondent No.8 and the amended memo of parties is taken on record. Registry is directed to do the needful.

Main case:

Prayer in the petition is to hand over the investigation in case bearing No. 191 dated 01.05.2016, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506, 302 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra, to some senior Officer of Haryana Police or to some independent Investigating Agency.

At the outset, learned State counsel points out that all 64 prosecution witnesses have been examined and now the case is fixed for 30.01.2023 for DWs.

Since all the prosecution witnesses have been examined, the relief as prayed for cannot be granted to the petitioners at this stage.

The petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
