The learned counsel representing the petitioner did not come forward to press the petition. This Court has gone through the pleadings.

The petitioner claiming to be the owner of a parcel of land located in village Bayen, Tehsil Ganaur, District Sonapat, claims a writ of mandamus to direct the respondents to disburse the compensation to the petitioner.

The petitioner alleges that some part of his land has been encroached upon by the National Highways Authority of India. The date, month and year on which the land was encroached upon has not been disclosed. The petitioner has also failed to furnish any particulars of the steps taken by the National Highway Authority for acquisition of the land. The entire case of the petitioner is based upon a report of the demarcation.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is lacking the material particulars. Hence, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one with better particulars.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
