The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0057 dated 05.04.2022 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No.4, Patiala, District Patiala.

By virtue of the order dated 25.04.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
