The petitioner is seeking to quash the FIR No.0379 dated 18.10.2018 under Sections 376 (2)/323 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station South Sector-34, Chandigarh on the basis of compromise/settlement.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Vijay Kumar, submits that the petitioner has died on 20.01.2021 and the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the categoric assertion made by learned counsel appearing for the U.T.Chandigarh, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. He shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned State counsel is found to be factually incorrect.
