The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India for seeking protection of her life and personal liberty from the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner is major and is staying in “One Stop Centre” Women and Child Development, Ambala. He submits that the petitioner is in relationship with Sameer Khan son of Sabir Khan since last eight years who belongs to Muslim Community with whom she wants to marry. He further submits that their relationship is not acceptable to the private respondents and as a result thereof, the private respondents are threatening the petitioner. A representation against the threat extended at the hands of the private respondents already stands submitted by the petitioner to the Superintendent of Police, District

Ambala(Annexure P-2).

The petitioner apprehends threat to her life and liberty at the hands of private respondents.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Pursuant to supply of advance copy, Mr. Ashish Yadav, Addl. A.G., Haryana has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned State counsel has no objection if appropriate direction for providing requisite protection to the petitioners is given.

As such, the petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Ambala to look into the grievances of the petitioner as set out in the petition and also expressed in the representation dated 18.04.2022(Annexure P-2) and take appropriate action for protection of her life and liberty as may be warranted by the circumstances.

The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above-said representation to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Ambala for requisite compliance.

The petition is disposed of.
