The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of an appropriate order or direction for quashing the impugned private complaint No. 155-I dated 26.03.2014 titled as “Rajbir Vs. Shamsher Singh Dahiya and others” under Sections 323, 325, 506, 148, 149 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and Section 3(X) of the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Hisar as well as summoning order dated 23.03.2016 (P-7) and order dated 14.10.2016 (Annexure P-9) vide which the revision filed by the petitioner has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in the present petition, primarily legal issues were raised, but however, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take up all the points on merits as well as the legal arguments available to the petitioners.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of, in view of the abovesaid order.
