Learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon an order passed by the respondents themselves in the case of another person, dated 20.09.2018 (copy Annexure P-7), as also an order/judgment of this court dated 24.04.2018, passed in CWP No. 9989-2018 (copy Annexure P-6), with him seeking the same relief.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioners at this stage would be satisfied if the respondents are directed to decide his legal notice after duly taken into consideration the aforesaid judgments/orders.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice dated 22.09.2021 (copy Annexure P-9), within a period of 03 months from the date of the receipt of a certified copy of this order, after duly hearing the petitioners and after duly considering the aforesaid judgments/orders.

If the judgments/orders are distinguishable on facts, it will be clearly stated vide a detailed speaking order as to how the petitioners' case is not covered by the judgments/orders.

Naturally, if the petitioners are found to be entitled to the relief, the consequential relief would be granted immediately thereafter.

However, it is made clear that this court has not made any comment on the actual merits of the case.
