1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 04.04.2022 in CRM-M-12710-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 04.04.2022 reveals that CRM-M-12710-2022 was disposed of by directing the Deputy Commissioner, Panipat to decide representation dated 14.04.2022 filed by the petitioner by passing a speaking and reasoned order within seven days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel states that in view of speaking order dated 18.05.2022 having been passed by the respondent, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 18.05.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not

calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
