Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0048 dated 25.03.2022 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Daresi, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

This Court vide order dated 25.04.2022 directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/ Investigating Officer subject to the conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. The petitioner was directed to join investigation and co-operate with the Investigating Agency as and when required.

Today, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, pursuant to the order dated 25.04.2022 passed by this Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions states that pursuant to the order dated 25.04.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the

investigation and he is not required any more for custodial interrogation at this stage.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that in case the Investigating Agency requires the petitioner to appear, he shall make himself available without any demur.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioner is allowed and the order dated 25.04.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute, subject to compliance of conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
