Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* for appointment of a Warrant Officer, to search for the detenue namely Jaspinder Singh S/o Baljinder Singh.

Reply by way of affidavit of Rajesh Sharma, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Special Branch, Ludhiana, Additional Charge as ACP, Industrial Area-B, Ludhiana has been filed in the Court today. Copy thereof has been furnished to the counsel for the petitioner.

Report of the Warrant Officer has also been received and has been perused by this Court.

A perusal of the same shows that the alleged detenue had been called for inquiry in relation to case FIR No.39 dated 19.04.2022 registered under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Shimlapuri, Ludhiana on 20.04.2022 and he had been allowed to go on the same

day itself.

The said fact has not been controverted by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed as not pressed.
