ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Aggrieved by allegedly interference, intimidation and threats at the instance of the accused, the complainant has come up before this Court for cancellation of bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 14.01.2022 passed in CRM-M-54748-2021.

Learned counsel for the accused submits that he has no fire arms with him. He has also submitted an affidavit qua his submission.

Given the nature of allegations, this Court disposed the petition by modifying the order dated 14.01.2022 by imposing the following two conditions:-

a) that till the completion of the trial, the respondent-accused shall not contact, call, text, message, remark, stare, stalk, make any gestures or express any unusual or inappropriate, verbal or otherwise objectionable behavior towards the complainant and complainant's family, either physically, or through phone call or any other social media, through any other mode, nor shall unnecessarily roam around the complainant's home.

b) that the respondent-accused shall not enter the property, workplace, and the residence of the victim and shall also not enter within a radius of one kilometer from the victim's home till the

recording of the statements of all non-official and informal witnesses in the trial. This Court is imposing this condition to rule out any attempt by the accused to incapacitate, influence, or cause any discomfort to the victim.
